Significance of Newell Hall

Newell Hall is one of the University of Florida's turn of the century (1909) Collegiate Gothic style buildings, designed by
William A. Edwards. With its classical-Beaux Arts plan, materials,
load bearing walls, and Tudor Gothic details. Newell Hall exemplifies
the architectural taste of its day - the emphasis for facade design,
with symmetrical placement, decor and ornate trim. Due to financial
limitations at the time of construction and renovation in 1943-44,
Newell Hall has no interior features of architectural merit; however,
the large rooms, high ceilings, high multi-pane windows, and intimate
spaces in the gable and attic floors create the potential for useful
and exciting spaces. Newell Hall represents a specific period in the
building and architectural development of the University of Florida;
as one of the earliest existing buildings on campus it stands as a
testament to the beginning history of the University of Florida.








